I have a number of concerns with this project, including the way the consultation process has been carried out. We (local residents within 400m - 1km of this site) were not advised of this proposal. As a consequence, I have no confidence that the management plans to mitigate problems associated with dust, odour or noise (either for construction or during operation) will be effective.

Also, why wasn't the search for a suitable site expanded to include areas outside Western Sydney? We are already burdened with a large number of waste treatment facilities in Lidcombe, Greenville, Eastern Creek, Kemps Creek. Who is "taking responsibility" as per the National Waste Policy, if another plant to treat waste is to be located in Western Sydney? Please also note that the commercial waste (coming to Grand Ave) is being generated and collected from small businesses across the Sydney CBD and the green and food waste is being collected by groups of councils.

Furthermore, it is insensitive to propose this type of plant operation on the former James Hardie site. I have neighbours whose family members worked for James Hardie and subsequently passed away from asbestos related illnesses.

This proposal is an unfair burden on our local community, residents of, workersⁱⁿ, and tourists to Parramatta. I oppose it.
