Dear Sir,

The scale and operation of the proposed development will significantly negatively impact our neighbourhood (which includes Elizabeth Farm & a Heritage walk) by:

- Exacerbating traffic problems (The Traffic report provided indicates that traffic on James Ruse Drive **currently** exceeds capacity, yet an additional 288 movements per day – of garbage trucks, rigid & articulated vehicles, 8.8 to 12.5 m wide - are not considered to warrant improvements to the road system)
- Increasing the possibility of exposure to a number of health hazards (such as dust, noise, foul smells) which will/can have adverse consequences on our wellbeing
- Exposing us to contamination when accidents/ leaks occur
- Disturbing our sleep (It's a 24/7 operation and 10pm is too late to turn off the industrial shredders.)
- Dominating the skyline

Therefore, we object to the proposal and advise that the consultation process has been very poor (almost non existent).
