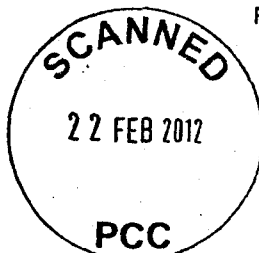

### **Remondis Alternative Waste Treatment Facility, Camellia (10\_0028) Exhibition of Environmental Assessment**

The Department has received an Environmental Assessment (EA) from Remondis Pty Ltd and Billbergia Pty Ltd for the above referenced project. The project includes:

- a Commercial & Industrial Resource Recovery Facility (CIRRF) with a capacity to process up to 100,000 tonnes per annum (tpa) of commercial and industrial waste;
- a Source Separated Organic Resource Recovery Facility (SSORRF) facility with a capacity to process 50,000 tpa of food and green waste; and
- ancillary infrastructure.

Part 3A of the EP&A Act, as in force immediately before its repeal on 1 October 2011 and as modified by Schedule 6A to the Act, continues to apply to transitional Part 3A projects. Director-General's environmental assessment requirements (DGRs) have been issued in respect of this project and the environmental assessment report was lodged prior to 1 October 2011. The project is therefore a transitional Part 3A project.

Consequently, this report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Part 3A and associated regulations, the Minister (or his delegate) will therefore assessed and determined the carrying out of the project under section 75J of the Act.

The Department will exhibit the Environmental Assessment from **Thursday 23 February 2012** until **Tuesday 10 April 2012**. Copies of the Environmental Assessment will be sent to you directly by the Proponent. Please advise if you have not received them by the exhibition start date. It would be appreciated if you could make a copy of the Environmental Assessment available for public inspection at your office. Submissions are due by the end of the exhibition period. A submission by way of objection must set out the reasons for objection. The Department invites Parramatta Council to make a detailed submission on the project by **Tuesday 10 April 2012**.
