As discussed at the meeting on Tuesday 8 May, TfNSW does not have guidelines or criteria such as resident or worker numbers for when a bus service should be provided to service any particular land use development. However, in relation to the proposed Cronulla Leagues redevelopment we can advise that:

- At completion of stage 1 of the development (25%), the developer could liaise with TfNSW to discuss planning for a public bus service connecting the site to the surrounding area (eg Cronulla, Caringbah and Miranda)
- It is suggested that TfNSW be notified as each individual DA is submitted, to ensure that TfNSW is aware of the timing of the development staging.
