Dear Mr Bright,

I refer to your letter outlining changes to the development proposed for 5 Whiteside Street and 14 – 16 David Avenue North Ryde (10 _0165) and write to register my ongoing complaint and opposition of the development.

I attach my previous correspondence and reiterate that the development for the general area is still too high at 6 storeys and the building is still only meters from the boundaries of my house and from the bedrooms of my home.

The traffic caused by 163 occupants is still unacceptable and the local roads will not cope with the extra traffic. There are already extreme traffic issues on Lane Cove Road and Epping Road that create a continual Peak Hour for most of the day.

The amenity of the development does not suit the predominately 1 and 2 storey homes in the area and I and my family stongly object to the original and amended proposal.

We live at the above adress which is adjacent to no 5 Whiteside ST. north Ryde.

The aumers of N' 5 are seeking approval from the NSW Department of Planning and Infrastructure to build three (3) Residential Buildings of various heights.

We are concerned, in particular, about the height of a eight (8) storeys building at the Back of our property, only meters from our house.

We think the building would be to close and too high. Ampacting detrimentally to the quality of our life.

The height of the building will cost a shadow on our house for many hours every day. Depriving us of natural light.

We use the courtyard to enter and exit our house. Walk to and from the Garage have a clother line and ply area for so our teenages doughter. The courtyard is an extention of the living area of our house.

We are concerned about noises and air pullation. There is an entrance/exit for motor vehicles in the back of our house, only six(6) meters from our bedroom window. The distance between the back well of our house and the fence of the proposed building ranges between 4½ and 6 meters. Our courtyard lacks depht.

We believe high rise developement is not appropriate for this area.

We have been living in This house for the last 21 years.

We are afroid such developement, if is settle allowed to go ahead, will impact detrementally on our lives.
