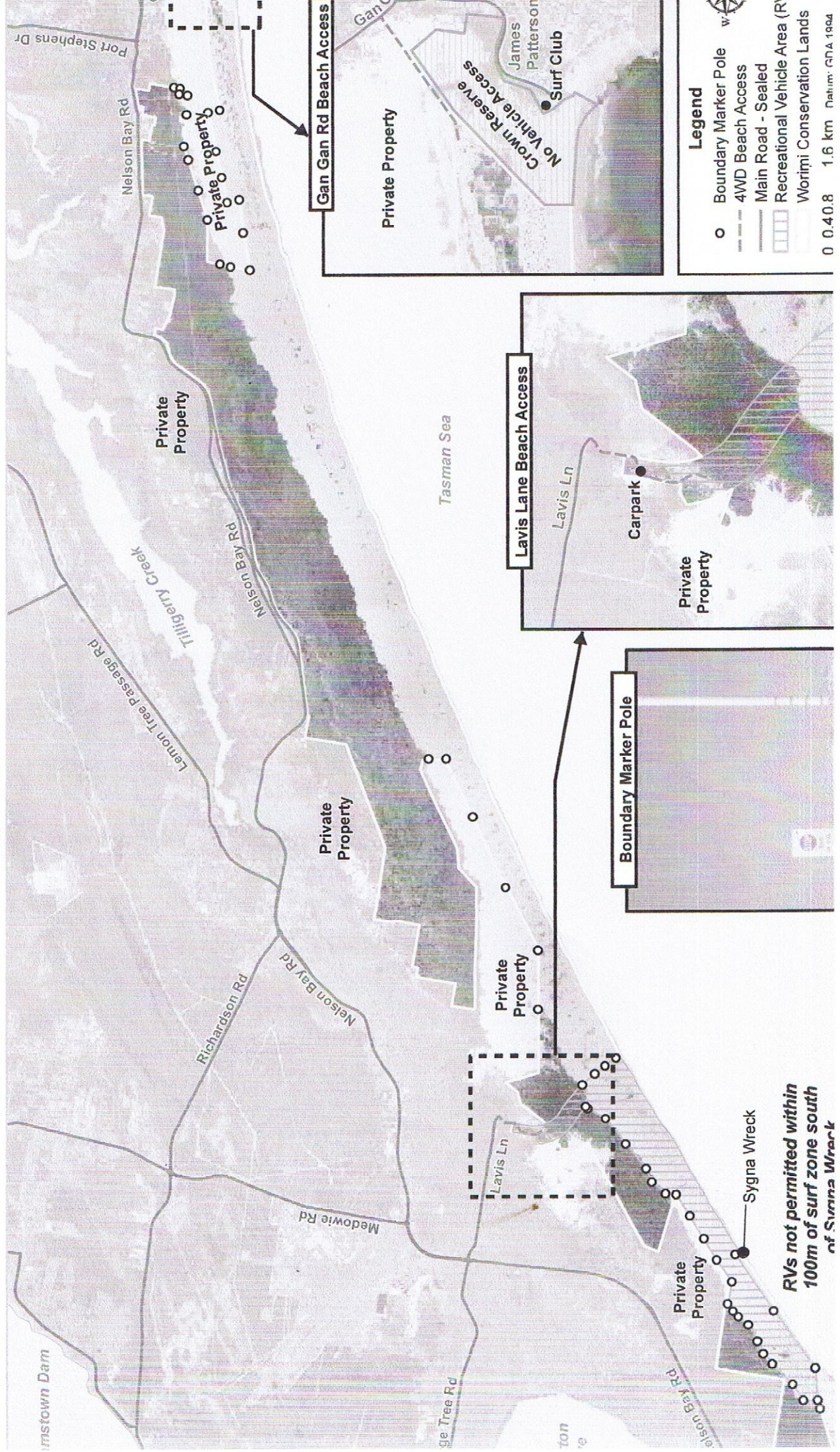


- ▶ Take care when swimming or fishing within the Worimi Conservation Lands, as strong rips, undercurrents and dangerous surf conditions sometimes occur along the beach.
- ▶ The beach within Worimi Conservation Lands is unpatrolled. Birubi Surf Lifesaving Club patrol a swimming area in adjacent Birubi Point Crown Reserve near Anna Bay.

- ▶ Take all of your rubbish with you.
- ▶ No vehicles are permitted on vegetation, Aboriginal middens or shell accumulations.
- ▶ Dogs are permitted on the beachfront only and must remain on a leash.
- ▶ No firearms or other weapons are permitted.
- ▶ Check the tide chart—the best time to travel is low tide.

- ▶ Road rules apply to driving in the Worimi Conservation Lands. You must display a current Beach Vehicle Permit on your vehicle. Motorbikes, motorbikes and other recreational vehicles (RV) require additional registration, and must remain within the designated zone.
- ▶ Driving is permitted only within 100m of the mean high tide mark. Recreational vehicles (RVs) are not permitted within 100m of the mean high tide mark. Recreational sites and historic sites are protected.
