Review of Operations and Likely Developments

Council has received the report from the consultants that were engaged to undertake a review of children's services. Both Council and Management are evaluating the recommendations to enable a number of them to be incorporated into the Schemes strategic plan. A report has been received from the consultant that was appointed to review the 3 Aged Nursing Homes to ensure they meet the new building certification instrument devised by the Commonwealth.

Department of Aged and Community Care. Upgrading work will shortly commence to address the items needing to be addressed. With the relocation of the Administration Department from the Elste Hill Building to the Medical Centre an application has been lodged with Manly Council to utilise that building as a Guest House. If approved it will generate additional income for the Scheme,

Significant Changes in the State of Affairs

There have been no significant changes in the way in which the Scheme conducted its business activities during the year.

- b) a contravention of sections 182 or 183 of the Corporation Act 2001; as permitted by section 199B of the Corporation Act 2001.

The total amount of the insurance contract premium was \$4,445.
