I refer to the Department's email of 24 July 2012 (ref: MP10_0231) with regard to the Preferred Project Report (PPR) and Response to Submissions (RtS) for the abovementioned application, which was referred to Roads and Maritime Services for comment.

RMS has reviewed the PPR & RtS and raises no objection as the proposed development will not have a significant impact on the classified road network.

However, RMS provides the following advisory comments to the Department for tis consideration in the determination of the Concept Plan:

- 1. Shuttle bus services between the train station and the University should be increased to cater for additional students and staff to ensure there is a reasonable modal split to public transport.
- The layout of the proposed car parking areas, loading docks and access driveway associated with the subject development (including, driveways, grades, turn paths, sight distance requirements, aisle widths, aisle lengths, and parking bay dimensions) should be in accordance with AS 2890.1- 2004 and AS 2890.2 – 2002 for heavy vehicle usage.
- 3. A Construction Traffic Management Plan (CTMP) detailing construction vehicle routes, number of trucks, hours of operation, access arrangements and traffic control should be submitted to Council prior to the issue of a construction certificate. The CTMP will need to ensure that any impacts on pedestrian and bicycle access and on bus services an bus stops during construction are addressed, the latter two in consultation with STA.
