Dear Amy,

We refer to your email of 12 July 2012 higher resolution images and detail for the Preferred Project Report (PPR) lodged.

Each of the points raised are addressed below.

1. Morning and evening peak traffic movements

The traffic generation rates of 256 and 296 movements are for the lower and upper range respectively for the evening peak.

The corresponding traffic generation for the morning peak is 206 and 233 movements for the lower and upper range respectively.

It is also noted that these generation rates would be further reduced by 36 and 52 movements (morning and evening) respectively if the lower car parking provision for commercial and retail are adopted.

2. Open space and street dedication and evening peak traffic movements

As detailed in Attachment 1, proposed open space and proposed dedication plan the areas of open space and dedication have been further clarified

Public streets dedicated to Council	3,530m ²
Public open space dedicated to Council	4,806m ²
Publicly accessible open space (not dedicated)	5,287m ²
Publicly accessible streets (not dedicated)	1,415m ²
Communal open space (not dedicated)	1,390m ²

3. Amended Sections showing basements

The project architects have checked the sections provided on 20 June and all sections show the two basement levels where relevant.

6. RMS and Sydney Water responses

In relation to the RMS and Sydney Water responses received, we are meeting with RMS next Wednesday to finally resolve the outstanding matters.

In relation to the Sydney Water response our initial view is that the information requested is seeking to respond to stormwater management issues upstream from the development site and upon which the proposed development has no impacts.
