# Part 3A Development Proposal Western Mortlake 402 Units in 14 Buildings – 3 to 9 Storeys Increased Traffic Congestion Coming To You

Despite all the grandstanding and hoopla that Part 3A is dead, the State Liberal Government is pressing ahead with a Part 3A application for the western side of the Mortlake peninsula without reference to our community.

In general terms, the site is west of Hilly St to Majors Bay from Edwin St to past Whittaker St. Yet, the Liberal State Government have only notified the area between Bennett Lane, McDonald St, Tennyson Rd, Palace Lane, Hilly St rather than the whole of the Mortlake and Cabarita peninsulas, Breakfast Point and areas of Concord that will be adversely impacted by the increased motor vehicle traffic generated by a residential development of this large size.

### Why the secrecy?

So that you get a perspective of the size of this development, I have detailed the current controls and what is proposed:

3 – 4 storeys	9 storeys

The exhibition period ends on 17 November 2011.



#### Some Background

The site is an old industrial area and is probably subject to contamination in certain areas and will hence need remediation.

The City of Canada Bay has long held concerns about additional development on the Mortlake peninsula, primarily due to the issue of traffic generation and the limited public transport that is readily available. The existing controls reflect these concerns.



The proposal doubles the controls and does not address the issue of traffic generation or provide for any increase in public transport.
