## 2 PROPONENT AND CONSULTANT TEAM

NSW Health is made up of the Department of Health, the Health Administration Corporation, the Ambulance Service of NSW, and public health organisations. The Department of Health is responsible for ensuring that the people of NSW are provided with good health care. It monitors the performance of the NSW public health system and supports the statutory role of the NSW Minister for Health.

The Department has statewide responsibility for providing:

- Strategic planning and statewide policy development
- Improvements to public health
- Performance management
