# SCHEDULE 2 CONDITIONS

#### THE APPROVAL IS MODIFIED BY:

- 1. Delete condition 1.5 and replace with the following:
  - 1.5 This project approval shall lapse on 27 February 2017, unless works the subject of this approval are physically and substantially commenced on or before that time.
- 3. Insert the following condition after condition 1.15:

#### **Environmental Update**

1.16 Within three months prior to the commencement of construction, the Proponent shall prepare and submit to the Director-General, a report prepared in consultation with the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) and Council which demonstrates how the Operational Air and Noise impacts are consistent with relevant environmental performance standards current at the time of the report's preparation, taking into account nearby sensitive receivers. In the event of any inconsistency between the current standards (at the time of the report's preparation) and conditions 2.4 and 2.8, the most stringent shall apply. Construction shall not commence until the report has been approved by the Director-General.
