Dear Mr Ritchie

I refer to your correspondence received 20 November 2013 by the Office of Environment and Heritage (OEH) requesting comment on a Concept Plan Modification for the Kirrawee Brick Pit site, Princes Highway Kirrawee (MP10_0076 MOD 2).

The proposed modification includes a change to the timing for dewatering of the former Brick Pit excavated area to permit dewatering simultaneously with the construction of a temporary water source up to the point that a minimum of 800 sq. metres of water surface area is maintained. It is planned to recycle water removed from the water body into the temporary water source.

OEH does not raise concerns in regard to this modification provided that a minimum area of 800 sq. metres water surface area is maintained at all times and the water level, quality and clarity is in accordance with water quality guidelines as outlined by Equatica8 and Northrop and as agreed by Sutherland Council.
