The Environment Protection Authority (EPA) refers to your letter dated 11 November 2013 seeking comments relating to an application by Lend Lease (Millers Point) Pty Ltd to use an existing concrete batching plant to conduct further construction works at Barangaroo south. (MP06_0162 Mod 7 and SSD 5967).

The EPA refers also to the applicant's supporting information including the document titled: State Significant Development Environmental Impact Statement Barangaroo South Temporary Concrete Batching Plant (SSD 13_5967) Submitted to Department of Planning and Infrastructure On Behalf of Lend Lease (Millers Point) Pty Limited.

The EPA has reviewed the application and considers that the proposal will not give rise to any new or additional impacts over and above those associated with the currently approved plant. Furthermore, EPA considers that the conditions attached to Environment Protection Licence 13336 are sufficient to regulate any short-term impacts associated with the operation and ultimate decommissioning of the plant.

Accordingly the EPA has no objection on environmental grounds to DoPI approving the application should it decide to do so.
