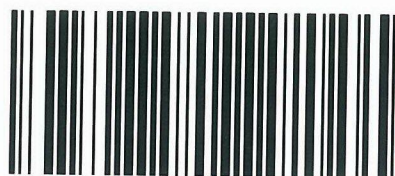

**Subject: Heritage Division comments on Major Project MP 10\_0076 MOPD 3 - Kirrawee Brick Pits.**

The Heritage Division received your email on the 20<sup>th</sup> of February, 2014 requesting comment on the above project.

The Heritage Division notes that it has had dealings with this site previously, specifically issuing a S140 Approval under the Heritage Act for archaeology at the site in 2007, commenting on a previous DA for the site in 2008 and providing comments in February 2011 on the Environmental Assessment for Major Project 10\_0076.

A review of the proponent's supporting statement for the proposed Modification 3 shows that the modification relates to an amendment of the approved Concept Plan to create a series of urban blocks to break up the scale of the site as well as the introduction of a linear street and pedestrian network through the site.

It is noted that the archaeology of pipe kilns which remain on site and which are supposed to be incorporated in the development have not been addressed in this documentation.

Whether this is because the proposed modification does not impact these items, or because there were not considered important enough to take into account, remains unclear. Unfortunately, this means the Heritage Division is unable to provide comment on this proposal at this time as the submitted reports do not include information relating to the heritage of the site.
