I wish to register my objection to the proposed Abalone farm as above for the following reasons,

- 1. The proposed site for this project is in an area of natural beauty with wetlands and a rich diversity of bird and animal life.
- 2. The site lies adjacent to the quite village of South Pindimar with approximately one hundred residents.
- 3. Noise from the machinery running 24hrs a day 7 days a week would be absolutely intolerable and would be detrimental to the residents health and well being.
- 4. The four sea pipes extending into the Port would kill sea grasses so important to ecology.
- 5. The pipes discharging waste into the Port Stephens 9 Kms from the sea would leave a residual, thus causing the risk of marine life mollusc (ganglioneuritis) disease. (This similar situation has occurred in Victoria and the the risk is real it may happen here.
- 6. Should this type of factory be allowed it will set a precedent for the future.
- 7. Tourism, Oyster farming and fishing generates thousands of jobs and to put this at risk is totally unacceptable.
