Introduction

Our vision for North Eveleigh is to create a vibrant mixed use (live/work/shop/entertainment) community with it's own distinct identity that celebrates the sites industrial heritage and reconnects with the surrounding neighbourhood.

The creation of open spaces formed on major axial links from the surrounding typology reestablishes the site. The proposed building forms respond to the existing street network and the existing heritage buildings.

A shared pedestrian spine links the precincts on the site creating a promenade activated by cultural facilities and public spaces.

Building typologies have been developed to create flexible commercially viable types that evolve from the heritage building typology and thus relate to the sites unique history and situation.

A landmark building will create a marker giving identity to the development and highlighting the location of a new pedestrian bridge (under a separate application) connecting the Railyard Site to Redfern Station.



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
