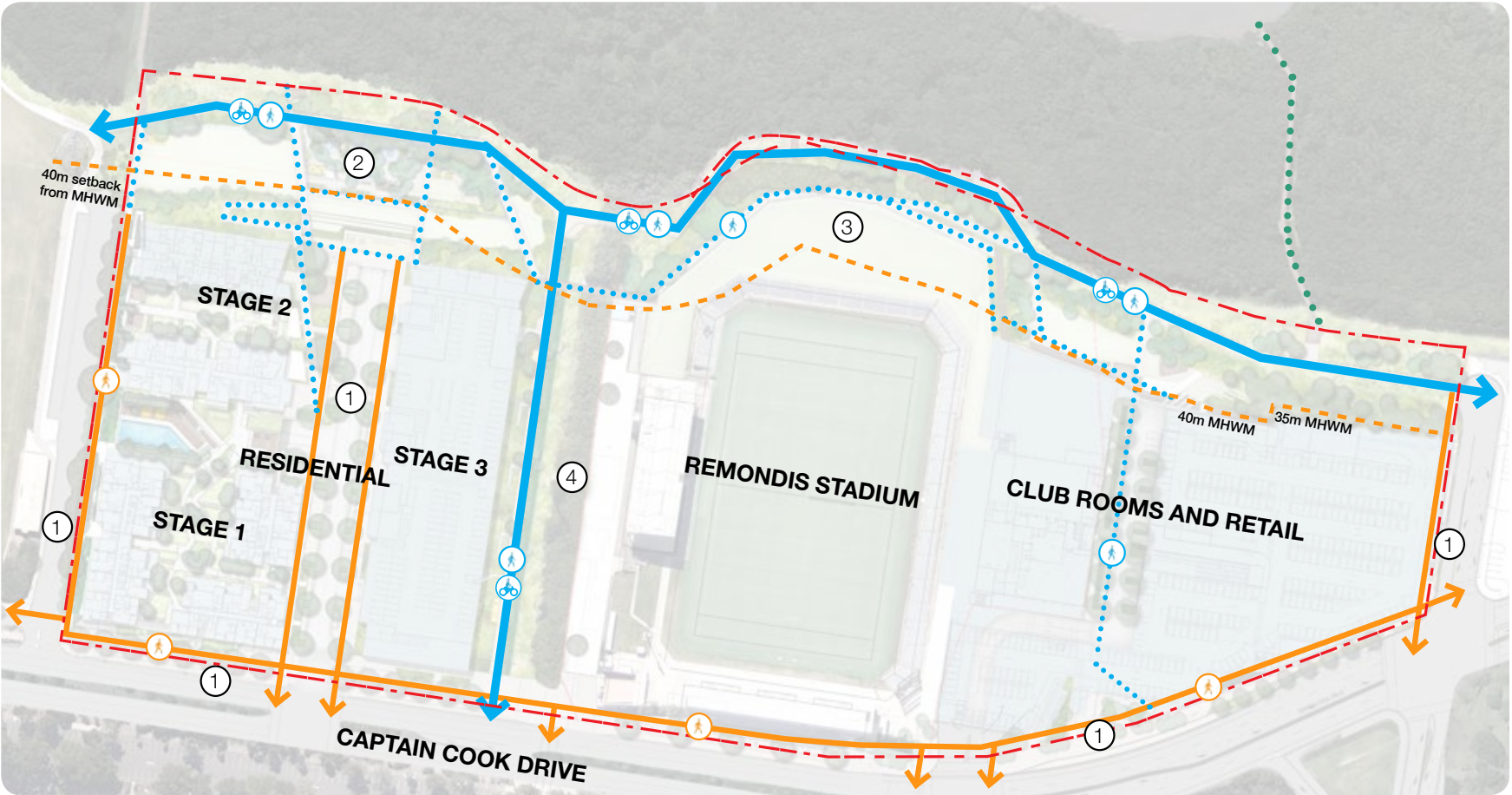

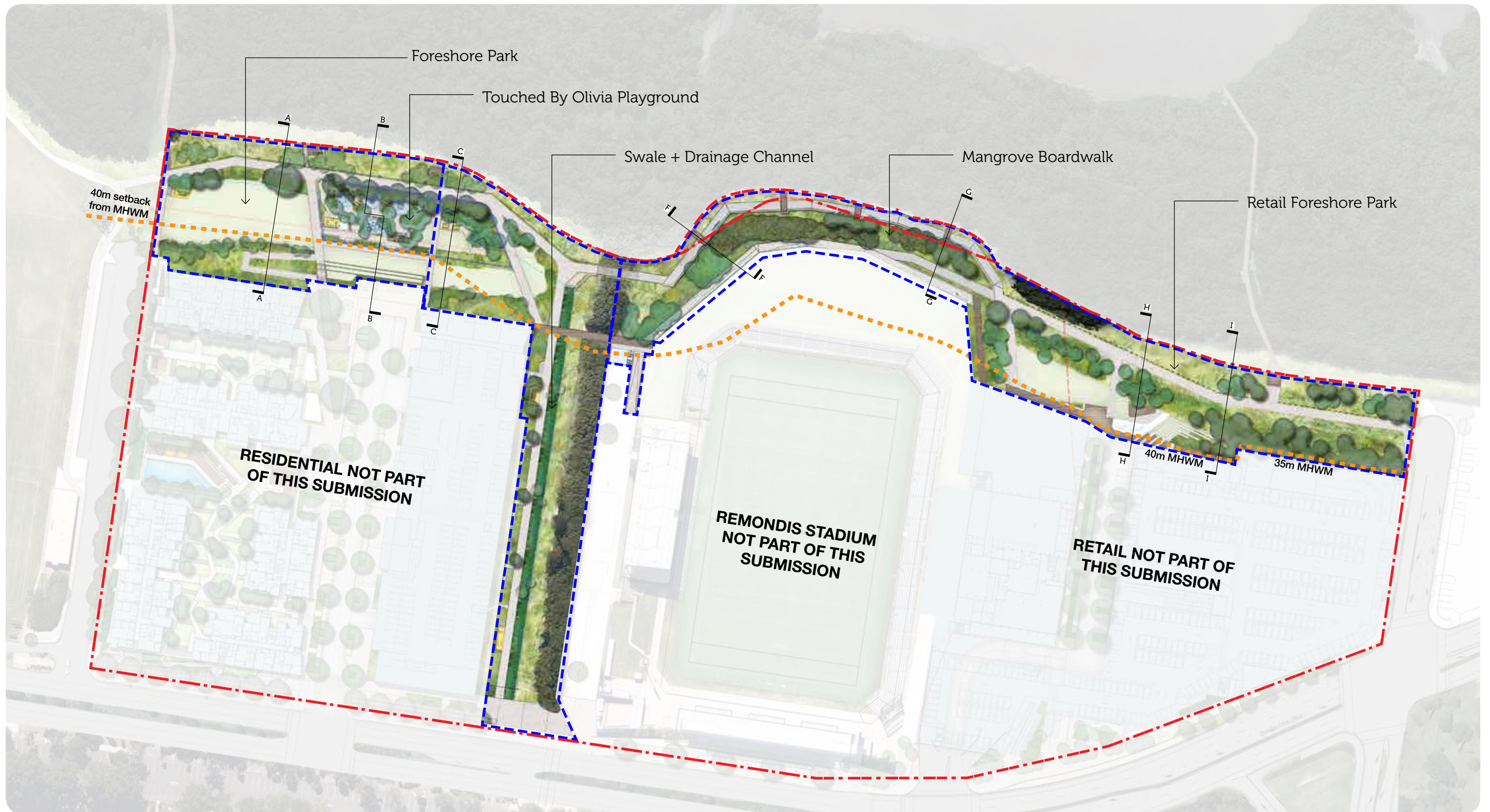

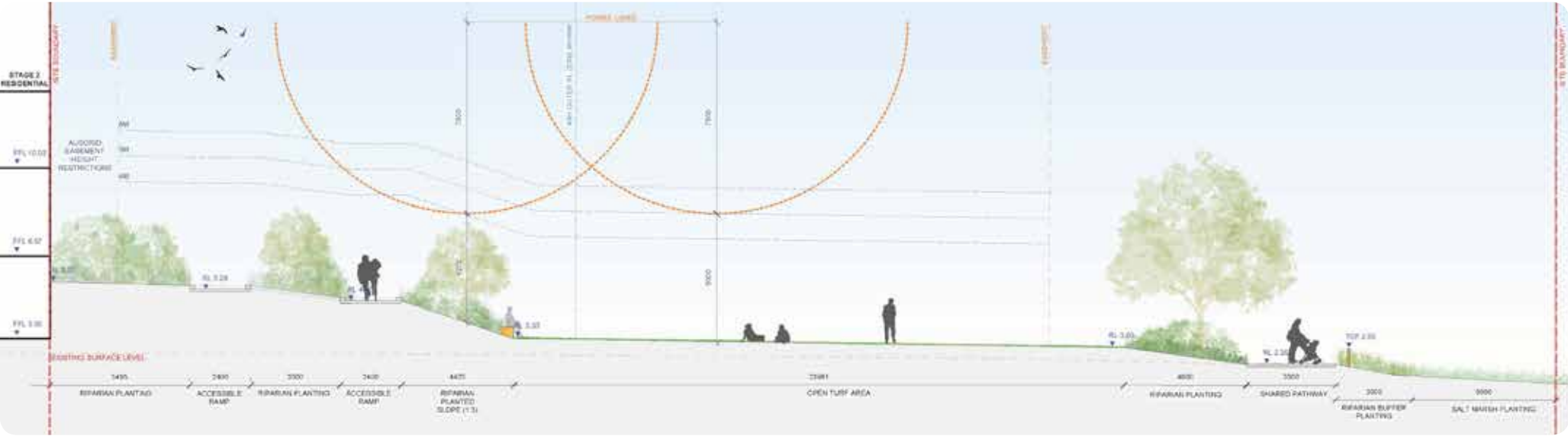

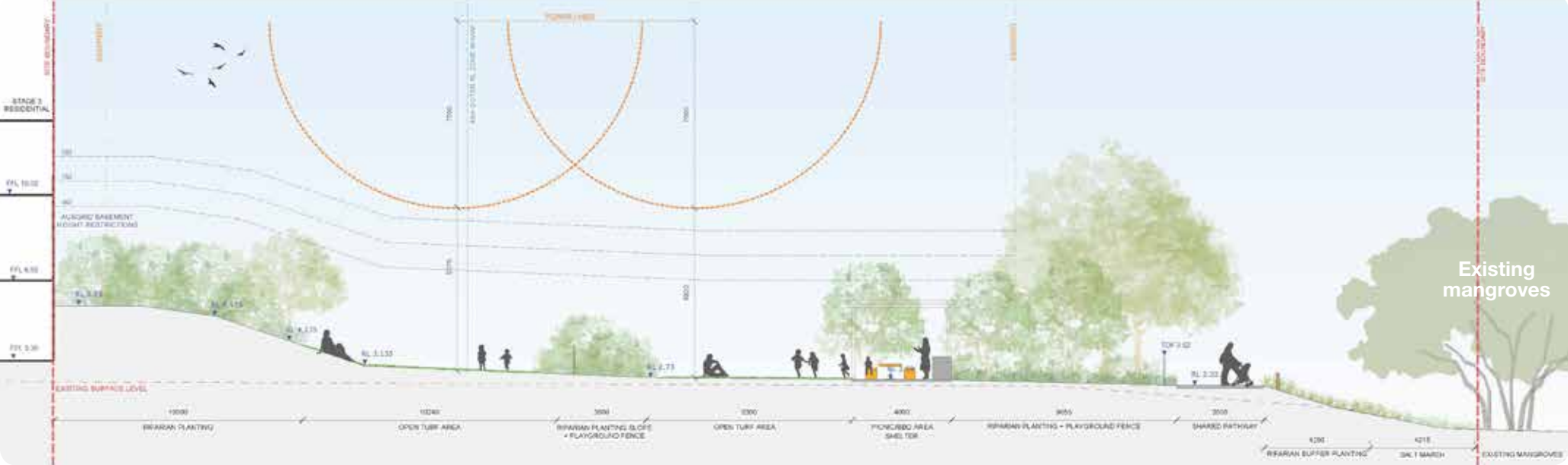
Foreshore Park - Looking West | Section AA

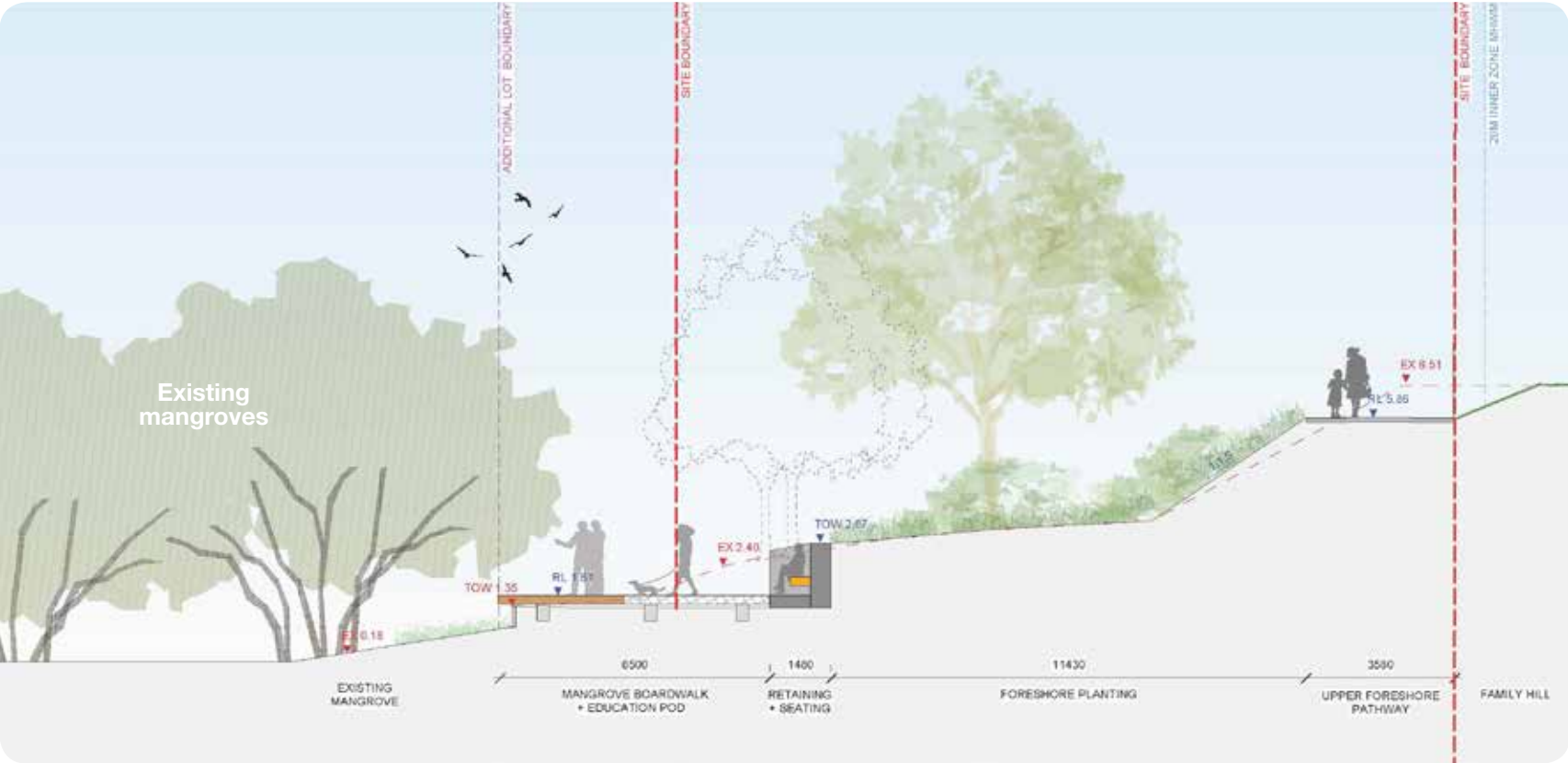

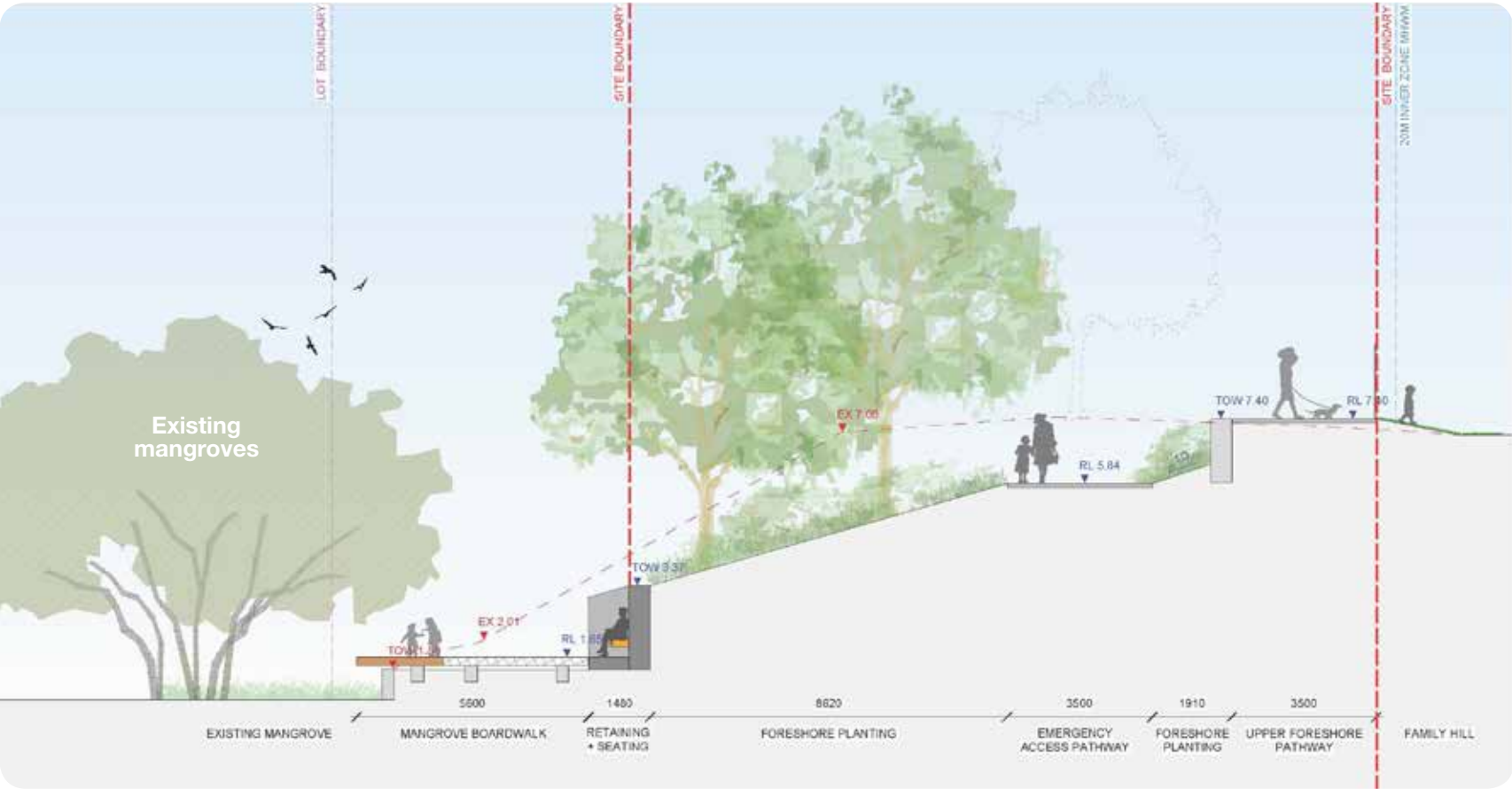
