**Modification of MP06\_0051 (Mod 6) to allow the Demolition of Buildings 7 and 9 at Royal North Shore Hospital (RNSH)**

Thank you for providing the submissions received from the Heritage Council of NSW and Willoughby Council in respect to the above application. Health Infrastructure (HI) has reviewed the comments made by both agencies and is generally in agreement with the comments made.

HI has taken initial steps to have a Conservation Management Plan (CMP) prepared for the RNSH site which will predominantly focus on the buildings that make up Precinct 3 as these building have been identified as having high significance. However this will not be completed prior to the need to demolish Building 7 and 9. In addition HI is happy to archivally record Buildings 7 and 9 prior to their demolition and to, where practicable and opportunities exist, salvage fabric and interpret these buildings and their historical settings in the future planning for the hospital.
