**Request for Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARs) for proposed modifications to the concept approval at the Channel 9 site, 6-30 Artarmon Road, Willoughby (MP10\_0198-MOD1)**

Reference is made to your correspondence received on 5 May 2016 requesting SEARs input from the Heritage Council of NSW (the Heritage Council) for amendments to the Master Plan involving an increase in building envelopes, dwelling numbers and associated amendments.


The proposed State Significant Development (SSD) site is in the vicinity of State Heritage Register item the Walter Burley Griffin Incinerator (SHR no. 00084).

It is recommended that the heritage SEARs are those as recommended below:

- *The Environmental Assessment must include a Heritage Impact Assessment (HIS) prepared in accordance with the guidelines in the NSW Heritage Manual that addresses the significance of, and provides an assessment of the impact of the proposal on the heritage significance Walter Burley Griffin Incinerator (SHR no. 00084).*
- *The Environmental Assessment must include an archaeological of Aboriginal and non-Indigenous archaeological resources, including an assessment of the significance and potential impact of the archaeological resources. The assessment should be prepared by suitably qualified archaeologists in accordance with all relevant guidelines.*
