I wish to formally object to the proposed helipad in Bardens Bay, Morisset Park, and to the subsequent helicopter movements over our homes, schools and work places.

I support the submissions put forward by the MPDAG – these are my views and I also support the views of David Whyte (ecology), Irene Bates (Acoutic) and Philip Ruffle (Lake Mac LEP 2004)

The impact for me personally is -

I live two houses from the new Trinity Point development and have experienced the helicopters in our air space- this is extremely close to our homes and very disruptive - we certainly would not want our lifestyle to be impacted with this on a regular basis. We did retire here for the serenity that this area provides, and in no way, want this to change. It certainly is an OH & S issue with the noise impact on all spectrums of the community that live here.

There are also many people in our area who do shift work and have moved here for the quietness which is needed for them to function in their lifestyle and family situations.

I am one of many senior ladies, plus families that regularly use the lake for recreational activities e.g. kayaking, and other water sports. I would not want this lifestyle or safety jeopardised in any way, or has to discontinue because of the trauma of impending disruptions from the helicopter activity. As it is, we need to go further into the lake to

navigate the marina, which now with the shark activity, isn't always desirable and a concern, especially with the senior people and children.

These are just a couple of issues raised, but as mentioned, I do support the submissions by MPDAG – these are all relevant and certainly very important for this entire area and beyond.

It is your duty to be conscious of the problems arising from such a development in our area, and to act responsibly for the community concerned.
