Touched by Olivia is a national charity building inclusion through play. Touched by Olivia supports communities to build inclusive playspaces, creates employment opportunities for people with disabilities at our social enterprise cafes, and advocates so that All Kids Can Play! Touched by Olivia began in 2006 when John and Justine Perkins daughter, Olivia, died from a rare disease at 8 months old. They decided they would create inclusive playspaces in Australia so that ALL kids could play together, side by side, regardless of age or ability. These playspaces are named for Olivia: Livvi's Place. As of April 2016, Touched by Olivia has opened 20 playspaces across Australia!

Touched by Olivia has entered a partnership with Capital Bluestone to create an inclusive community at Woollooware Bay. Together, we have consulted and engaged with thousands of local residents who are passionate about inclusion.

We've discussed the proposal with Capital Bluestone to develop more community spaces and have indicated our interest in facilitating inclusive playgroups should the space become available to us. Having weatherproof venue options ensures that vital social opportunities are not missed.
