5. Transport & accessibility impacts (Construction and Operational)

The EA shall address the following matters relevant to the proposed modifications:

- Provide an updated Traffic Management and Accessibility Plan and Transport & Accessibility Impact Study having regard to the proposed modifications, including but not limited to:
 - The traffic and transport impact having regard to the proposed extension of operating hours;
 - Any mitigation measures required to address the traffic and transport impact resulting from the proposed modification;
 - Provide updates to the details of access and parking arrangement as a result of the proposed amendments; and
 - Provide updates of the likely traffic and pedestrian impact of the proposal, i.e. new pedestrian bridge and amendments to Smidmore Street access, during construction.
