

## Section 75W (mod 6) Submission based on modification of the existing 75W (mod 1) concept plan.

The proposed modifications relate only to Stage 1 of the project involving the redevelopment of the existing industrial land south of Smidmore Street (13-55 Edinburgh Road) to create a two level free-standing retail addition to the shopping centre with roof top car parking.

The proposed modifications seek to refine the approved design, enhancing its design quality both internally and externally and its relationship with the public domain.

## Landscape Design Statement Notes for Section 75W Submission for **Smidmore Street Precinct**

These notes are to outline the modifications that are proposed for the Section 75W (mod 6) submission with reference to the original Landscape Design Statement for the Section 75W (mod 1) submission.

The notes seek to address the 3 street frontages with respect to the status of existing trees and the design concepts of these areas, with regard to the function of the area, design of the building frontage and any attention to changes in level.

An associated Arborist Report will be submitted in conjunction with this application which will include an assessment of the existing trees affected by the new development to the Smidmore Street Precinct.

#### General Landscape Concept / Materials

The overall concept is to improve the public domain on all frontages in particular on Smidmore street with upgraded finishes, seating, dog parking, bicycle parking and planting.

New footpaths and planting are proposed to Edinburgh Road and Murray Street.

## **Existing Trees & New Tree Planting**

There are a total of 13 existing trees on Smidmore Street, of which 10 are proposed for retention.

There are also existing trees on Edinburgh Road which as in the previous scheme are proposed for removal - they have no visual significance either being immature in status; of poor specimen quality (including severely lopped to accommodate powerlines overhead); or of an inappropriate species.

These 14 trees are proposed to replaced by 8 street trees in accordance with the Marrickville Street Tree Masterplan together with a further 5 trees on Murray Street, making a total of at least 13 new trees. In addition 4 existing Livistonia australis are proposed to be transplanted to a location to be agreed with council.

#### 1.0 Smidmore Street

A shareway area is proposed to link the Smidmore Street precinct development with that of Marrickville Metro Stage 2. A feature unit paving treatment connects the two stages. With sculptural bollards delineating the shared area to the pedestrian only area.

There are a number of large, good specimen Lemon scented Gum trees Corymbia citriodora on the southside of Smidmore Street which are proposed to be retained. Prevously two smaller specimen Eucalypt trees were proposed for removal, based on their visually poor specimen status. Now these and an additional specimen is proposed to enable the overhead pedestrian link, loading dock functionality and foot and roadway level changes.

Previously the streetscape was propsoed to be split lengthways into two levels to enable access to the building frontage. In the revised scheme the road and footpath levels gently rise to meet the levels of the building entrances.

The large existing trees to be retained compliment the scale of the building & the large scale architectural treatment of the frontage.

In order to retain one of the Lemon Scented Gum trees (T81) where the road and footpath rise to the Building entry it is proposed to suspend the paving over the existing tree level using a tree grille. The remaining Lemon Scented Gum will be accommodated in the sunken planting area surrounded by native grasses.

## 2.0 Edinburgh Road

There are a number of existing trees on Edinburgh Road however all are either immature; of poor specimen or inconsistent with the proposed treatment of the street. Eight new trees are proposed to be planted to the Edinburgh Road verge, using Lagestroemia indica tree species as specified in the Marrickville Street tree masterplan for this street.

Some small pockets of planting are proposed between the footpath and building to be planted with a variety of shrubs grasses and groundcovers.

The eastern end of Edinburgh Road is mainly a function of the bus interchange area, with the landscape treatment largely limited to functional hardscape elements.

## 3.0 Murray Street

There are no existing trees on Murray Street and the existing buildings provide an imposing industrial feel 5 new trees are proposed to be planted on this verge.

The street tree proposed for Murray Street is *Elaeocarpus eumundi* in accordance with the Marrickville Street tree masterplan.

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




