I object to the amendments proposed. The Shell Cove area is already becoming too congested with insufficient infrastructure and community services. The suggested raised building heights will take away from the Shellharbour areas coastal ambiance and be of detriment to the vibe of Shell Cove. As well as destroying the view of long time Shell Cove residents the increase in population will put a strain on the access roads which are already at a standstill in peak times. I am also concerned about a lack of adequate schools, medical facilities and community services in the area and if the current primary school, doctors surgeries and hospitals will be able to cope with the extra patronage. Residents of shell Cove have been misled if these changes are to be approved. They were sold on the promise of a relaxed, family orientated coastal lifestyle which is slowly being eroded away by developers greed.
