Further to the concerns already expressed about the proposed demolition of three houses in Fox Valley Road and the positioning there of a display unit to enable off the plan purchase of 200 units, it has come to our attention that the "proposed" display units were delivered to the Wahroonga Estate grounds yesterday. This is despite the fact that the DA has not yet been considered by Ku-Ring-Gai Council.

We consider this action to be extremely provocative. It is pre-empting any decision on the demolition and with the obvious intention of counteracting the very strong opposition from church congregations, parents and local residents. The developers should be required to remove those display units immediately, only to be returned if and when the DA is approved.

This action is yet another indication of the total disdain for proper community consultation shown by the hierarchy of the Australasian Conference Association Limited, which owns the land. The Adventist Church, the San Hospital and the Adventist schools have been supported by the community for many years. We respect the Adventists for the way in which they live according to their beliefs, respecting their neighbours. Unfortunately the actions of the Australasian Conference Association and the developers of the proposed units is very quickly eroding this respect.

Enough is enough!
