Thank you for forwarding the Key Issues report provided by the Department of Planning and environment, ref MP06_0101 MOD 2 and SSD8135.

We have reviewed item 13 in Schedule 1 which states that the accessible rooms should be located closer to the lifts. After a review of the plans, it is noted that whilst the accessible rooms are not the closest rooms to the lifts, they are no more than 20-25m from the lifts (depending on which lift is used).

There is no maximum mandatory distance specified in the Building Code of Australia or its referenced Australian Standards for the distance between the entry and accessible accommodation.

The Building Code of Australia does specify that accessible entries into buildings can be no more than 50m from an inaccessible entrance. It is considered that the distance from the lift to the accessible rooms is only half of the maximum distance allowed, and is therefore unlikely to be detrimental to a person living in the accessible rooms.

It is also noted that the location of the accessible rooms will ensure that general noise from the lifts and people in the corridors will be minimized, providing improved amenity in this respect.
