VEGETATION TRANSECT & PLOT DATA

In accordance with the requirements of the LMCC Flora and Fauna Guidelines (Forest Fauna Surveys *et al* 1997), four vegetation transects (minimum length 200m) and four vegetation plots (20X20m) were undertaken on site to provide additional data on the vegetation associations present.

Species identified via these methods are indicated in the following lists.
