9.4 Landscaping

The site will be comprehensively landscaped with the species and planting proposed complementing and improving the natural attributes of the site. 


Figure 27 - Landscape Concept





Figure 28 - Part Plan 1

9.5 Associated services and facilities

A number of the existing buildings on site including the Tennis Academy building along Oxford Falls Road and the three dwellings on the western portion of the site that connect to Barnes Road will be retained to provide social services and living quarters for permanent on site staff.

All residents will have access to a range of recreational, retail, office and support facilities.

Residents in the serviced apartments and independent living apartments will have access to the following services:

- General laundry and cleaning;
- On-site staff to provide:
 - Emergency assistance;
 - Assistance with personal care, mobility and communication;
 - Meals (including special diets);
 - Social activities; and
 - Support for people with dementia.

Residents in the high care facility will have access to additional services such as mobility aids, basic medication, therapy services and registered nurses to assess, plan and manage residents' care.

• All services and facilities identified on site will be accessible to residents with a continuous path to be provided.




Figure 30 - Communal Facilities and Services Plan
