Subject: A1703-01 Change of Use - Primary School to Childcare Centre

Proposal

This application is for the adaptive re-use of an existing 230 place primary school. The change of use includes minor alterations and additions to the exiting building fabric to meet the Education and Care Services National Regulations and meet current NCC compliance. Some of the more salient requirements of these are summarised in the following tables.
