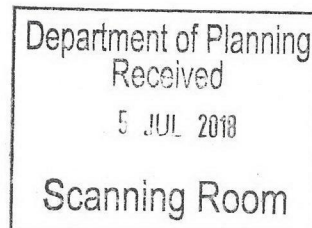

Objection to Helipad
Application No: MP 06 0309 MOD3

I am writing with regard to Johnson Property Groups response to community submissions objecting to the Trinity Point helipad.

I have lived here for 36 years and witnessed many waterbirds roosting and foraging on the shoreline of northern Bardens Bay and in particular Lake Petite which is a shallow haven for many, many species, so I strongly disagree with JPG's further report concerning the birdlife in this area. Their assessment was only done at high tide and further to this:-

Re: Appendix D Addendum Ecological Assessment:- the photographs taken at high tide (plates 8 & 9), are incorrect. These photographs are of the area at the Morisset Park Boat ramp, Bardens Bay. This is NOT Frying Pan Point (which is at Summerland Point), nowhere near Morisset Park. This is just one example of the MANY inaccuracies made in JPG's response.

Although JPG says their noise testing complies to ANEF standards I do not agree because as outlined in my original submission letter sent to you in January 2017, I will be affected very negatively by every single helicopter movement that would be coming and going so close to where I live.

My sentiments concerning the strong objections I have to this non-essential helipad have not changed infact since reading JPG's response they have increased.

I believe the responses by JPG to the very valid and intelligent objections made by an overwhelming majority of the community are based on reports commissioned and paid for by JPG that are NOT independant and unbiased.

Could I again respectfully ask those of you who will make the final decision to please consider these community objections to this proposal.

I declare I have not made any political donations within the last two years and I look forward to receiving a reply as to your decision.
