Thank you for your email of 2 October 2018 requesting comment from the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) on the modification of the Trinity Point mixed use development.

CASA has reviewed the information provided and has no comment to make on the development.

CASA does not regulate helicopter landing areas, however Civil Aviation Advisory Publication (CAAP) 92-2(2) *Guidelines on the establishment and operation of on-shore Helicopter Landing Sites* and CAAP 92-4(0) *Guidelines for the development and operation of off-shore helicopter landing sites, including vessels* provide guidance for these facilities. CASA recommends the proponent liaise with potential operators of the facility to ensure it is suitable for the intended operations and that obstacles adjacent to the landing area are not hazardous.
