• The document variously refers to the "Lake Illawarra Authority" and "Lake Illawarra Foreshore Authority" and these bodies do not exist. References to land previously managed directly by the LIA should now refer to the DPIE – Crown Lands.

• Appendix F response to WCC comments regarding Social Planning / Open Spaces / Public Benefits refers to Crown foreshore land as being potentially "embellished with a future Voluntary Planning Agreement". DPIE – Crown lands reiterates that Crown land is public land must not be burdened for private benefit, such as for open space to support private developments. It is not within the scope for DPIE – Crown Lands to either establish or maintain public recreation space or facilities. DPIE – Crown Lands supports WCC comments in this regard and considers this matter not to have been addressed or resolved
