Re: Casuarina Town Centre – Australian Lifeguards

On behalf of the Australian Lifeguard Service (ALS), I Scott McCartney would like to state that we agree in principle to the proposed facility located within the Icon Building with the proposed dimensions and access to Blue Horizon Drive to be provided by Clarence Property.

By way of background the ALS currently operates out of the Casuarina Hockey fields shed. This is far from idea as some of the main issues are:

- The lifeguards have to use their own transport to load and move lifeguard equipment from the shed to the beach location as its too far to walk.
- Have minimum room to store required equipment due to the hockey equipment also located in the shed.
- Damages to radios and rescue equipment often occur due to the amount of people coming in and out of the shed.
- Unsecure location for vandals and theft

In supporting the proposed facility located within the Icon Building, ALS requirements for the proposed new facility to be constructed in the ICON building, as outlined in our letter dated 31 May 2019 as attached

- Minimum 3.25m x 9.25m within the ICON Building for the ALS facility
- Vehicle access to the facility off Blue Horizon Drive via a roller door or similar
- 2 x Double power points
- 1 x water point
- Shelving to stow first aid and other equipment

ALS current needs for a facility to be available as soon as practical with clear benefits to ALS and the community. In this respect, the benefit to ALS if a temporary structure is provided within the Town

Centre prior to the Icon building being developed is preferred. Ideally a temporary structure like a shipping container /modular building located in the immediate vicinity of where the ALS shed/ICON building will be located would benefit the ALS in the short term as we could move away from the hockey shed and into a location more accessible. It would also benefit the community as we could establish the new patrol location with the community prior to the ALS shed being built. The location is also more central and will encourage more beachgoers to swim between the flags.

The ALS plans to operate the lifeguard service (patrol) out of the building during holiday periods. Here they will be able to keep all lifeguard equipment rescue ready as well as be able to charge radios, maintain equipment and reduce damages to equipment. With the new location we also plan to locate an ATV or RWC in the shed to increase our patrol and call out capacity for the area.

ALS support Clarence with their endeavours to approach Tweed Shire Council to secure necessary approvals to locate a temporary structure prior to the development of the Icon Building where our permanent facility will be provided. This facility and location would be beneficial from our end to perform the lifesaving duties that are expected and required from the Australian Lifeguard Service.
