**SCHEDULE 1**

The water and wastewater servicing of the West Dapto Urban Release Area and Adjacent Growth Areas comprising:

- the construction and operation of drinking water and wastewater pipelines, pumping stations, drinking water reservoirs and associated infrastructure; and
- upgrades to the Wollongong and Shellharbour sewage treatment plants.

The West Dapto Urban Release Area is defined as the suburbs of Kembla Grange, Sheaffes/Wongawilli, West Horsley, East Horsley, Cleveland, Avondale, Yallah/Marshall Mount and the Dapto Sub Regional Centre.

The Adjacent Growth Areas are defined as Tallawarra lands, Calderwood, Tullimbar Village and the Yellow Rock health care facility.

As generally shown on the indicative map prepared by Sydney Water dated July 2009 and titled *Indicative WDURA and Adjacent Servicing Areas*.

Note: The assessment of the project under Part 3A will include the consideration of one or more options for the alignment of the drinking water and wastewater pipelines and location of drinking water reservoirs.
