Jim,

In reply to your letter dated 28/6/07 regarding additional load at Cardinal Freeman Village Buildings A and B.

On 23/5/2006 we received an application by email for the same load increase for which you are making application. This application was submitted by Alan Skofic of SEMF. Energy Australia has also received applications from other consultants in respect to the site over the past 4 years. The most recent communication in respect of this site came from Mays Chalak of ITC Group.

Energy Australia has issued advise in reply to these applications which can be summarised as follows:

- There are numerous separate electrical supplies into the complex. These supplies are not from the same source of supply;
- The on site switchboards do not accurately reflect the sources and destinations of the supplies and loads;
- There are no single line diagrams available in case of an emergency so emergency personnel would have great difficulty identifying the source of supply to the individual buildings;
- Under emergency conditions, the Main Switchboards are inaccessible and/or not clearly identified;
- · Serious consideration be given to the consolidation of the existing supplies; and
- Additional supply can then be taken from the newly consolidated supply.

Our advise in reply to your letter is the same as list in the above dot points.
