RELOCATION AND UPGRADE OF EXISTING SCRAP HANDLING FACILITIES

BlueScope Steel (AIS) Pty Ltd submitted a request to the Department of Planning for the Minister to make a declaration under section 75B of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act) and clause 6 of the State Environmental Planning Policy (SEPP) (Major Development) 2005 that the proposed scrap handling project at the Port Kembla Steelworks is a project to which Part 3A of the EP&A Act applies.

The Deputy Director-General, as a delegate of the Minister, formed the opinion on 3 December 2009 that the proposal to relocate and upgrade the scrap handling facilities at the Port Kembla Steelworks was a project to which Part 3A of the EP&A Act applied.

We request the Director-General under Section 75F of the EP&A Act issue the requirements as to the level and scope of the necessary documentation and assessment for the preparation of an Environmental Assessment to accompany an Application for the project.

To support the request for the Director-General's requirements relating to the environmental assessment a Preliminary Environmental Assessment is attached. The Preliminary Environmental Assessment provides detail on the site location and an outline of the project and identifies key environmental and planning issues associated with the project.

The documentation contained and listed below is to effect the formal lodgement of the application for the Project with the Director-General (Section 75E) in seeking the Minister's determination of the Project;

gift means a gift within the meaning of Part 6 of the Election Funding and Disclosures Act 1981. Note, A gift includes a gift of money or the provision of any other valuable thing or service for no consideration or inadequate consideration.

Note: Under section 84(1) of the Election Funding and Disclosures Act 1981 gift is defined as follows:

gift means any disposition of property made by a person to another person, otherwise than by will, being a disposition made without consideration in money or money's worth or with inadequate consideration, and includes the provision of a service (other than volunteer labour) for no consideration or for inadequate consideration.

 - (b) in the case of disclosures under this Part by a major political donor—a political donation of or exceeding \$1,000:
 - (i) made by the major political donor to or for the benefit of a party, elected member, group or candidate, or

(ii) made to the major political donor.

- (2) A political donation of less than an amount specified in subsection (1) made by an entity or other person is to be treated as a reportable political donation if that and other separate political donations made by that entity or other person to the same party, elected member, group, candidate or person within the same financial year (ending 30 June) would, if aggregated, constitute a reportable political donation under subsection (1).
- A political donation of less than an amount specified in subsection (1) made by an entity or other person to a party is to be treated as a reportable political donation if that and other separate political donations made by that entity or person to an associated party within the same financial year (ending 30 June) would, if aggregated, constitute a reportable political donation under subsection (1). This subsection does not apply in connection with disclosures of political donations by
