Neighbourhood Park

This new park in the south of the site will connect to surrounding streets via a network of pedestrian walks. Built form to the north provides excellent solar access while a deep soil zone enables provision of extensive shade tree plantings.

- The park features:
- A large central lawn with surrounding pedestrian walks
 - A cafe terrace comprised of deciduous planting and timber decking along the Building 3 /south edge
 - A seating area on the western edge framed by deciduous trees and a largespecimen fig tree.
 - Seating and feature trees set within a wider pedestrian zone adjacent the supermarket
