



Improvements to Discovery Point Park

This park is a major publically accessible park and heritage element. A series of discrete interventions will improve connectivity between park and urban areas and within the park itself including:

- A new Park Promenade linking Chapel Plaza, the Verge -Vine pedestrian plaza, the new Station Park, continuing east to Cooks River, past Buildings 6 & 7.
- Several new pedestrian paths link to the new park promenade at various locations within the park while other paths, seating areas and plantings enhance overall pedestrian amenity and visual quality.
- Extensive planting surrounding rail infrastructure will reduce the visual impacts of the rail cutting, from within the park and adjoining apartment buildings. Service access to both rail equipment and Energy Australia substations will be integrated into plantings, as will setback distances of trees from rail infrastructure.
- The stockpile of Phoenix palms will delineate the view corridor from Tempe House to Fatima Island
