



**Waterside Park**

Brodie Spark Drive culminates in a generous open space offering striking views and direct pedestrian access to Cooks River.

The park features:

- An upper plaza and pedestrian shared zone with water element
- Universal pedestrian access, centrally located and extensively landscaped
- A shared pedestrian & bike path along the north-western edge, part of the site's cycle network
- A mid-level plaza offering seating, water feature and expansive water views
- An open lawn connecting the mid-level plaza to the creek side open space with feature simple yet robust concrete benches for seating and informal children's play.
- A water edge featuring mangrove, salt grass & littoral vegetation integrated with bleacher steps and controlled access to the water edge enabling activities such as kayaking.
