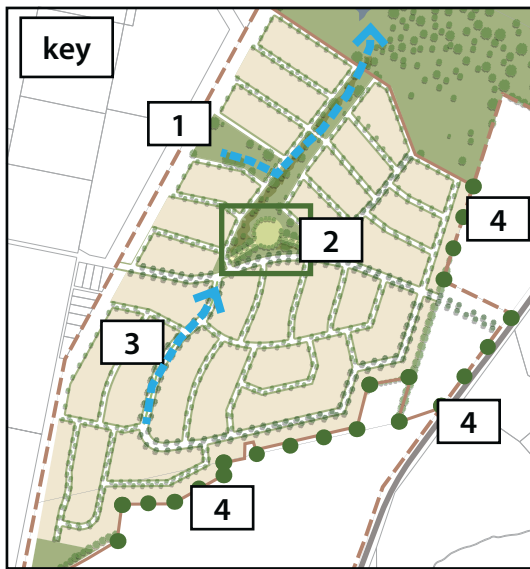
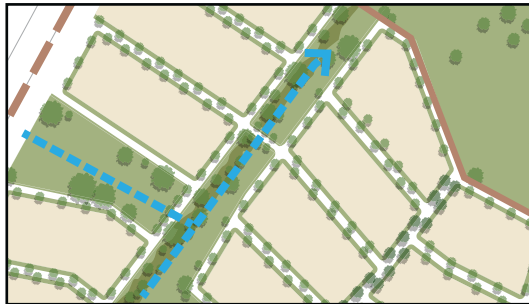




1. Riparian Corridor

A naturally planted drainage corridor providing water management and incorporating cycle & pedestrian paths as well as providing passive recreational uses.



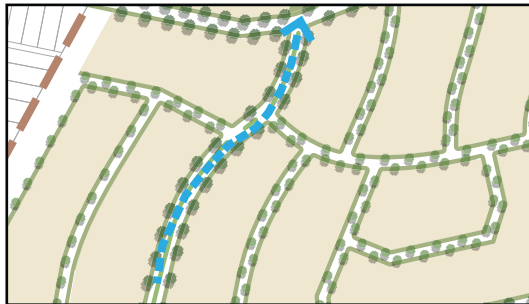
2. Local Park

Provides passive and active recreational opportunities including picnic areas, children's play & kick around areas. A mix of shady and sunny areas. The Local Park will become a recreational focal point that connects the riparian corridor to the neighbourhood and to external cycle routes.



3. Swale Street

A naturally landscaped central or side swale following the street down the contours connecting to the riparian corridor as it enters the site near the local park.



4. Tree Screening

Preserve existing tree screening along Forest Road where possible and along the DII Research Facility boundary.

Provide additional screening along Southern boundary and to the rear of the Carmen & Private Hospital sites where necessary.
