6-18 Parramatta Road Homebush – Proposed Mixed Use Development.

I refer to our meeting on 17 September 2009 regarding the above proposal. In order for the Department to consider your proposal a Major Project you will be required to submit a formal request to the Department of Planning seeking an opinion that the proposal is a Major Project to be determined under *Part 3A* of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979*.

Your submission should also request the Minister for Planning to authorise a Concept Plan for the proposal (if required) and the Director General's Environmental Assessment requirements, should the proposal be declared a Major Project.

To support your request you should submit a Preliminary Environmental Assessment. The Preliminary Environmental Assessment shall provide details on the site, the proposed development (including the statutory and strategic context) and provide a summary of the key issues associated with the proposal. A Quantity Surveyor's Certificate outlining the Capital Investment Value (CIV) of the proposal and a Political Donation Disclosure Statement is also required.

As indicated at our meeting, based on a preliminary review of the proposal, the Department raises concern with non-compliances with Council's controls, particularly in relation to the height controls contained within the *Strathfield Development Control Plan NO 20 - Parramatta Road Corridor Area*. Furthermore, the proposal's impact on nearby town centres and it's integration with the adjacent Bakehouse Quarter, will require careful consideration.
