On behalf of the Ingleburn North Public School community I would like to express our opposition to the proposed annihilation of Bambi Kindergarten.

Bambi Kindergarten has provided over fifty years of service for our community. Emotive as this sounds, Bambi Kindergarten is a cultural icon and its loss will be sorely felt.

In this area there is no other not-for-profit child care centre, managed by the parents themselves. It acts as a feeder child care centre for our school and a large number of our students are Bambi Kindergarten graduates.

It has been stated that a child care centre will be needed in the future, as Edmondson Park grows. I implore you reconsider a decision that will see us lose a childcare centre that already operates successfully, has a historical place in our community and is one that bears the dedication of a succession of hard working professionals and parents.
