I am a resident of Mayfield East, 42 Henson Ave

I have only very recently heard about the Newcastle Port Corp. plans to re-develop the old BHP site as a port complex. I understand that although the official closing date for submissions has passed, that it is reasonable for us to send this late Submission to you, with a copy to the NSW Dept of Planning.

I also understand that that the Newcastle Port Corp has agreed to accept late submissions up to 15th Oct; provided they are lodged via John Hayes of Correct Planning & Consultation for Mayfield group; and that they have agreed to give them proper weight and consideration.

My main concerns about the Port Corporation's Concept Plans are:

1. Almost all freight in and out of the proposed Port Facilities will be by road.

2. I understand this reliance on road transport could result in more than 1,000,000 extra truck movements PA using Industrial Drive, Mayfield and that it will impact upon feeder roads, Expressways and Highways in and out of Newcastle and The Hunter.

3. Most disturbing I see no evidence in the proposed plans to upgrade a Goods rail services to reduce the use of road transport and the associated noise and air pollution and road congestion.

4. I believe the lack of planning for rail transport is not in the best interests of the People of Newcastle, The Hunter, and beyond, because of the:

Traffic Issues and resulting Environmental and Pollution problems of exhaust fumes, dust, vibrations and noise;

Lack of Safety for Road users and residents;

The social and economic problems which could reasonably be seen as a 'flow on' effect from a heavy reliance on road transport.

I believe it is in the interests of all parties and a better planned concept plan for the Port re-development to request:
