I strongly object to the underground power lines being put at the front of my home for the Edmondson Park SWRL.

I have worked hard over the years to maintain and grow my garden and trees and I disagree with Integral Energy or Transport Construction Association digging up something I have found value in. I have spent a large amount of money on trees and fencing and I would expect if this goes ahead and there is damage done to my property, my trees, and or my fencing to be fully compensated. I would expect everything to be replaced exactly as it was, in that my trees be exactly the same size as they were. Any damage done to my fencing has to be repaired exactly the same and of the same quality. Also I object to the noise and inconvenience that will occur in our quiet semi-rural community. Also what are the effects medically having underground power lines so close to my home? I have two young children and I strongly object to them being subjected to the noise and disruption of the underground electricity power lines being put in, I don't understand why my family must be disrupted for a substation that is not wanted and in the very first draft not included. I don't understand why you are coming out of your boundaries and not keeping it within Edmondson Park, there is no reason you need to do it within Denham Court. We moved here for its semi-rural community, calm and quietness and I object strongly to it being taken from me.
