**1. Proposed main Power Substation at corner of Zouch and Campbelltown Roads, Edmondson Park. [Former Army Site]**

I fully support this location because it is;

- a. Wholly contained within the new Edmondson Park development;
- b. Future development can design around it;
- c. Future road widening of Campbelltown Road will be a natural barrier between this site and Edmondson Park East.;
- d. It has minimum impact on existing residential development nearby.

**2. Proposed Power Substation location in Cassidy Street, Denham Court.**

This proposed Power Substation appeared on a plan with no consultation with impacted residents in Cassidy Street.


The footprint of this proposed Substation and it's associated works is the size of a football field. This proposal and it's access road is only 50 metres from the house at 85 Cassidy Street. It will have a major impact on the amenity residents now enjoy in Cassidy Street. [especially No's 85 & 75].

This proposed Substation should be relocated to the northern side of the SWRL line ,within the existing transmission easement and the rail corridor land away from established homes that are not part of the Edmondson Park redevelopment.

**3. Proposed Underground Electricity Powerline, Cassidy Street, Culverston Avenue and Zouch Road, Denham Court. [between the two Substations]**

This proposed underground powerline could now be kept within Edmondson Park along a more direct path with more efficient construction, no remedial rework of driveways pathways and roadside shoulders. Future development can design around this preferred route.
