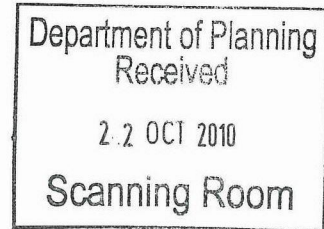

Part 3A Application Edmondson Park – Bambi Kindergarten

I refer to the public exhibition of the Part 3A Application by Landcom, for the future development of land at Edmondson Park, and the impact of such application on the future of Bambi Kindergarten located on Stevens Road.

Whilst Bambi Kindergarten is situated within the Liverpool local government area (LGA), the community within the Campbelltown LGA has benefited from the services provided by the kindergarten for many years, and continues to do so.

Council considers that it is important to acknowledge and preserve the history surrounding Bambi Kindergarten. It was established in 1952 by the wives of Australian soldiers during the Korean campaign, and in 1997 a Memorial Garden was established in the grounds honouring the soldiers missing in action during the Korean combat.

In light of the important service currently being given by the kindergarten to the wider community (including Campbelltown LGA), and its significance with regard to the Ingleburn Army Camp, Council wishes to advise the Department of its strong support for the retention and continuation of this valuable community asset.
