## **Forests**

Open tree canopy dominated by eucalypt species (typically > 10m in height) with crowns that touch or overlap. Canopy allows most sunlight to penetrate supporting growth of a prominent understorey layer varying between hard-leaved shrubs to luxuriant soft leaved shrubs, ferns and herbs.

## **Short Heath**

Shrubby vegetation less than 2 metres in height. Often more open in canopy. Prinicpal plant species include banksias, spider flowers, wattles, legumes, eucalypts, tea-trees, paper barks, she-oaks, grass trees, cord rushes and sedges. Grasses are scarce. Not found in arid and semi-arid locations.
