This site is a very significant historical site and also a very large block of land in North Sydney. As such, careful thought needs to be given to its development. The best way to do this is to have public inquiry to obtain a wide cross-section of views. The current proposal by Shore envisages some very large buildings on the site. These are out of character with the rest of the site and the historical significance of the site. In addition the clearing of undergrowth and a large number trees will significantly change the site for the worse. Graythwaite will begin to lose its historical parkland setting. The pressure of development over time will likely ensure that once this process starts it will continue until very little of the original parkland setting remains.
