I am a long-time resident of North Sydney area. I live at 104 Shirley Road, Wollstonecraft, and soon to reside at 1-5 Russell St, Wollstonecraft. I have lived in the area for 13 years. I also work in the area (see below).

I wish to lodge my opposition to the planned development of the Graythwaite site. I think there has been little or no community consultation; or if there has, it has been selective, suggesting manipulation of the sample.


I think a five storey school building by Shore College is out of character with this historic site, and I respectfully suggest that residents in the municipality beyond the 'immediate' area of adjoining streets need to be included in any consultation, as all residents are affected by this development to the detriment of quality of life and character of the neighbourhood in the lower north shore.
